

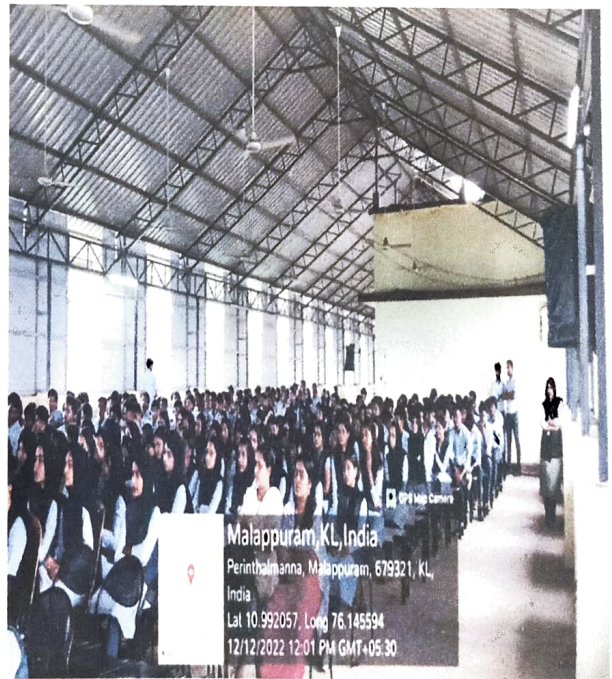
PROGRAM REPORT
