PROGRAM REPORT

DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS & STATISTICS KERALA - AGRICULTURE CENSUS 2022-2023

10.05.2023 TO 30.05.2023

The Agriculture Census 2022-23, organized by the Department of Economics and Statistics in Kerala, was a significant endeavor that aimed to gather comprehensive agricultural data. To facilitate the successful execution of this survey, the cooperation of the GEMS NSS unit was enlisted. The survey kicked off with a series of preparatory steps, including understanding the survey's purpose, obtaining identity cards, and setting up registration forms on mobile phones. This initial groundwork allowed the NSS team to actively engage in the survey process. The collaboration between the NSS unit and the Department of Economics and Statistics became evident as the NSS team visited the Malappuram Collectorate. Here, they interacted with an officer named Jyotish to obtain further guidance and direction for the upcoming survey. With the groundwork in place, the NSS unit commenced the survey on the following day, embarking on a journey to gather vital agricultural and household information. The scope of the survey was extensive, spanning 19 wards within the Kootilangadi Gram Panchayath. Under the leadership of the Department of Economics and Statistics, the NSS unit collected a range of data, including the names of the family heads, their father's names, land ownership details, mobile numbers, and house numbers.

This collaborative approach not only helped to complete the survey efficiently but also provided students with an opportunity to interact with a diverse range of individuals within their community. Each ward encompassed a considerable number of households, ranging from 350 to 500, making the survey a substantial undertaking. Upon completing the surveys in all the designated wards, the collected information was then uploaded onto the Agri phase app.
