

#### PROGRAM REPORT

#### COVID CARE DESK

#### 02.06.2020

In response to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the College Union for the academic year 2020-2021 launched a COVID Care Desk Program on 02.06.2020to support and safeguard the health and well-being of postgraduate exam writing students of the college and School of Distance Education. The program was inaugurated by the College Principal, Dr. Naveen Mohan, who emphasized the importance of these initiatives during these challenging times. Mask Distribution: As a part of the program, masks were distributed to all postgraduate exam writing students. The distribution aimed to promote safety measures and ensure that students had access to necessary protective gear. This was coordinated by 5 union members.

A dedicated help desk was established to provide information, guidance, and assistance related to COVID-19. Trained volunteers were available to address queries, provide information on safety protocols, and offer support to students in need.
