




The Following graphical representations show the Teachers Feedback Analysis

This pie chart shows the response from the teacher's feedback analysis about the question of "Effectiveness of the curriculum". 59% of teachers agreed Excellent on the effectiveness of the curriculum, 39% agreed with Good and 2% agreed with Average.









The course's syllabus has broadened our understanding and perspective on the subject, according to 63% of teachers who rated it as Excellent. 33% of teachers rated it as Good and only 4% rated it as Average.
