YEAR 2021-2022

In the academic year, 2021-2022, our institution took a giant leap by extending access to Embase beyond faculty, making it available to students and parents, emphasizing transparency and engagement in the educational process. This enhancement allowed parents to stay informed and actively participate in their child's academic journey. We also expanded the functionalities of the software by introducing features that allowed teachers to apply for leaves electronically and enabled students to monitor their attendance on an hourly basis. Notably, we transitioned our admission, office, and finance departments to operate entirely within the Embase software ecosystem, paving the way for a more comprehensive approach to e-governance.

The journey towards complete e-governance was not without challenges, including faculty adaptation difficulties, student engagement hurdles, administrative transition issues, and the learning curve for new faculty members.
