PROGRAMME REPORT

During the challenging period of quarantine due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the College Union of the academic year 2018-19 initiated the "15-Day Challenge Program" to engage students and promote their skills and creativity while staying at home. The program utilized various online platforms for participation and interaction. All these activities were conducted through online platforms to maintain social distancing and prevent the spread of COVID-19.

The 15-Day Challenge Program witnessed active participation from students, who embraced the opportunity to channel their creativity and learn new skills. The online nature of the program allowed for easy submission and sharing of content, fostering a sense of community even in the face of physical isolation. The program not only kept students engaged during quarantine but also helped them develop new skills, share their passions, and connect with their peers in a time when physical interactions were limited. It promoted a sense of resilience and adaptability in the face of challenging circumstances. The 15-Day Challenge Program organized by the College Union in 2018–19 successfully utilized online platforms to keep students engaged, creative, and connected during a period of quarantine. It served as an example of how virtual initiatives can bring the college community together even in challenging times.

Activities and Categories:

- 1. Film Review: Participants were encouraged to watch and review films, sharing their insights and critiques with others.
- 2. Photography: Students showcased their photography skills, capturing unique moments and perspectives from within their homes.
- Cartoon Creation: Cartoon enthusiasts were given the opportunity to express their creativity through original cartoon drawings.
- 4. TikTok Challenges: Students engaged in fun and entertaining TikTok challenges, keeping spirits high during isolation.
- 5. Storytelling: Participants shared their storytelling abilities, crafting and narrating short stories.
