PROGRAMME REPORT

Introduction: On September 21, 2021, a program was organized in connection with World Alzheimer's Day, aimed at raising awareness about Alzheimer's disease and promoting cognitive health. As part of the program, a Stroop Test and Memory Test were conducted to evaluate participants' cognitive abilities and educate them about the importance of early detection and intervention.

Program Details: The program took place in a community hall and attracted participants of different age groups. The event began with a presentation on Alzheimer's disease, covering its symptoms, risk factors, and available treatments. The presentation also emphasized the importance of maintaining a healthy lifestyle to reduce the risk of cognitive decline. Following the presentation, the Stroop Test was conducted. The Stroop Test is a widely used psychological test that measures attention, cognitive flexibility, and processing speed. After the Stroop Test, the Memory Test was administered. This test evaluated participants' memory recall abilities by presenting them with a series of words, images, and numbers, and later asking them to recall as many items as possible. The Memory Test assessed short-term memory, long-term memory, and working memory. A total of 100 participants took part in the Stroop Test and Memory Test. The results showed variations in performance across different age groups. Older participants generally exhibited slower response times and lower accuracy in the Stroop Test compared to younger participants. Similarly, the Memory Test revealed that older individuals had more difficulty recalling items compared to their younger counterparts.

Conclusion: The World Alzheimer's Day program, featuring the Stroop Test and Memory Test, successfully achieved its objectives of raising awareness about Alzheimer's disease, promoting early detection and intervention strategies, and assessing participants' cognitive abilities. By increasing knowledge and understanding, this program contributes to the overall efforts to combat Alzheimer's disease and improve the lives of individuals affected by it.

The Tau Day celebration was a successful event that helped to promote interest and awareness in mathematics.

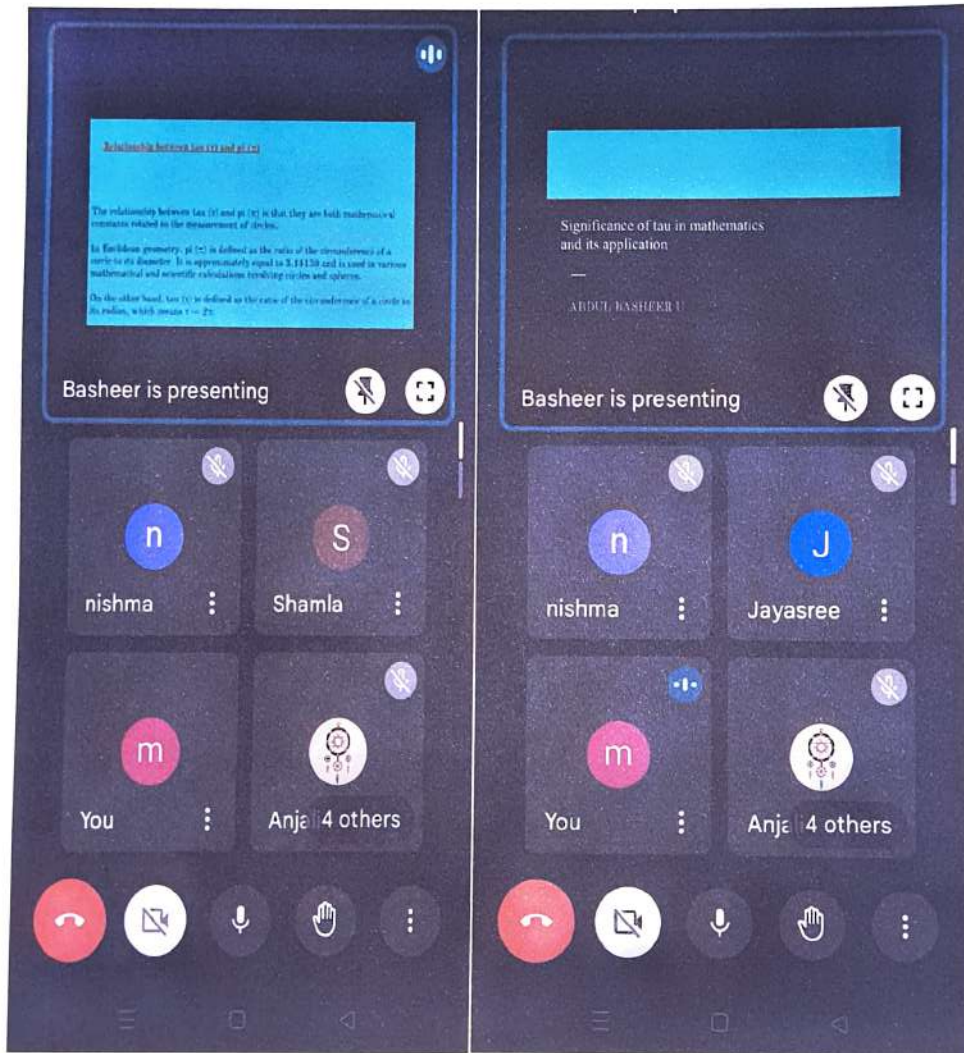

The first webinar was conducted on World Environment day, 5th June 2021 at 10.30AM. The Speaker for the same was Dr Girish Gopinath, Associate Professor, Department of Climate Variability and Aquatic Ecosystem, KUFOS, Cochin. The webinar was for a duration of one and half hour with the participation of entire students of the Department and faculty members. It was both interesting and informative at the same time. The Webinar began with a Welcome address by Abdul Rahman C V, Head of the Department followed by an introductory note about the Speaker and topic by Kavya B Krishnan, Assistant Professor, P.G Department of Applied Geology.

The Speaker gave a talk on "Tracking the Environment from Space" which is one of the latest advances in the research area. He talked on latest satellites used and technologies invented for the purpose of analysis and investigation. Each topic became more interesting as he kept talking. As climate change is becoming one of the greatest long-term challenges that society is facing, its consequences on Earth are more and more visible, starting with its color, when observed from space. To anticipate the consequences of global warming and protect our planet, we need precise information about how the natural environment is changing. Some Earth Observation satellites can provide reliable and highly accurate information on Earth over long periods of time and on a global scale. While meteorology was the first scientific discipline to use space capabilities in the 1960s, satellites are now able to help us monitor how healthy – or not – the planet we call home is, based on a broad range of data including weather analyses, the oceans' color and temperature, or measures of earth gravity.

After a brief interactive session, the session was concluded with the vote of thanks delivered by Kavya B Krishnan, Assistant Professor, PG Department of Applied Geology.
