
PROGRAMME REPORT

In commemoration of World Water Day, the PG Department of Applied Geology In association with IQAC conducted an extension activity to spread awareness on water regulation and conservation. The program was named AQUAPHILE which aimed to make people aware of the importance of conservation and proper management of water resources. The activity was conducted by 1ST M.Sc applied geology students under the guidance of Mr. Abdul Rahman C V and other faculties on 22nd MARCH 2023 at areas in Puzhakkattiri Gramapanchayath.

Students visited houses in the area to check some water quality parameters such as Total Dissolved Solids and Electrical conductivity which indicate whether the water is good for drinking purposes or not. They also took small classes on various artificial recharge techniques through which they can conserve rainwater as the area is affected by water scarcity during the summer months, he explained various steps to enhance the water quality and spread awareness about the importance of water conservation and management.
