
#### PROGRAMME REPORT

On October 9, 2020, an online gender awareness programme titled "How to Eliminate Gender Bias in the Classroom" was organised for students. The objective of the programme was to raise awareness about gender biases and stereotypes prevalent in educational settings and provide strategies to promote a more inclusive and equitable learning environment. The programme commenced at 10:00 AM and featured Mohammed Niyaf.C, Assistant Professor of Commerce department as the resource person. Through his expertise and experience, he aimed to sensitise the students about the importance of addressing gender biases in classrooms. The session began with an overview of gender bias, highlighting its impact on individuals and society. The resource person discussed various forms of gender bias commonly found in educational settings, including differential treatment, biassed expectations, and limited representation of women in textbooks and curriculum. 
