


PROGRAMME REPORT






PROGRAMME REPORT

WEBINAR ON POST COVID CHANGES-PG DEPARTMENT OF BIOTECHNOLOGY

PROGRAMME REPORT

The webinar on Post-COVID Changes, presented by Dr. Abdulla Adil, Senior Resident in Critical Care Medicine, took place on June 25, 2021, at 7:00 PM. The webinar aimed to shed light on the long-term effects and transformations observed in healthcare systems, society, and individuals following the COVID-19 pandemic. This report summarizes the key points covered during the webinar. Dr. Adil highlighted the significant strain placed on healthcare systems globally during the COVID-19 pandemic. The surge in cases overwhelmed hospitals, revealing weaknesses in infrastructure and resource management. Consequently, many healthcare facilities have reevaluated their preparedness for future pandemics and have started implementing strategies to enhance capacity and resilience. The pandemic accelerated the adoption of telemedicine and digital healthcare solutions. Dr. Adil emphasized the role of telehealth in facilitating remote consultations, reducing unnecessary hospital visits, and minimizing the risk of disease transmission. The webinar discussed the challenges and benefits of telemedicine, as well as the need for improved regulations and infrastructure to support its widespread implementation. The psychological impact of the pandemic has been substantial. Dr. Adil addressed the increased prevalence of anxiety, depression, and post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) among individuals affected by COVID-19. The webinar emphasized the importance of mental health support and the need for healthcare systems to prioritize psychological well-being in post-pandemic recovery plans.Long COVID, also known as postacute sequelae of SARS-CoV-2 infection (PASC), was a significant topic of discussion during the webinar. Dr. Adil provided insights into the persistent symptoms experienced by some individuals even after recovering from acute COVID-19. The presentation covered the various manifestations of long COVID syndrome, potential underlying mechanisms, and ongoing research efforts to understand and manage this condition. The webinar also addressed the importance of widespread vaccination in controlling the pandemic. Dr. Adil emphasized the need for continued vaccination campaigns to achieve herd immunity and prevent future outbreaks. The presentation touched upon vaccine hesitancy, the efficacy of different vaccines, and the role of healthcare professionals in promoting vaccine confidence among the population.



It is expected that the knowledge gained during this program will inspire continued interest in yoga and contribute to the overall health and wellness of the college community in the future.


