- Data Collection: The lecture discussed various data collection methods, such as interviews, surveys, observations, and document analysis. It emphasised the importance of ensuring data validity, reliability, and ethics.
- 4. Data Analysis: The lecture introduced different data analysis techniques, including quantitative and qualitative methods. It stressed the significance of data coding, thematic analysis, and statistical analysis based on research objectives.
