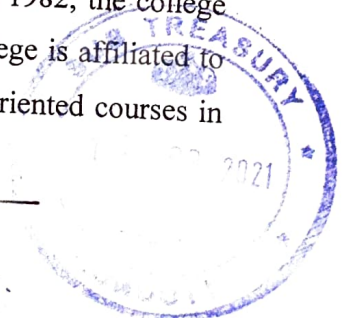

OBJECTIVES

1. The two educational institutions will;
 - a) Co-operate in the exchange of information relating to their activities in teaching and research in areas of mutual interests.
 - b) Promote appropriate joint research projects.
 - c) Conduct study camps and workshops that facilitate learning activities.
 - d) Conduct seminars, and international conferences that impart expertise knowledge, motivation, and confidence.
 - e) Faculty and student exchange programs in the field of mutual interests.
2. The aim of the MoU shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration and this shall be subject to periodic review by both campuses.
3. The host institution agrees to assist in the seeking of appropriate housing and to supply a workspace, library, and technical facilities as appropriate.
4. In the implementation of specific cooperative programs, a written agreement covering all relevant aspects including funding and the applications to be undertaken by each party will be negotiated, mutually agreed and formalized in writing, prior to the commencement of the project.
5. Establish a mutually beneficial partnership between colleges that allows a flexible and creative response to the organizational, missions, and fiscal needs of both institutions.
6. Shared use of facilities including classrooms, office, and library facilities that reduce operating costs and promote collaboration of students, security, staff, and community members in program success.

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS AND TIME FRAME

This MoU will commence on 01/08/2021 for a period of 5 years. This MoU is the complete agreement between the Department of Biotechnology of both, EMEA College of Arts and Science, Kondotti, and GEMS Arts & Science College, Ramapuram and may be amended only by written agreement signed by each of the parties involved.

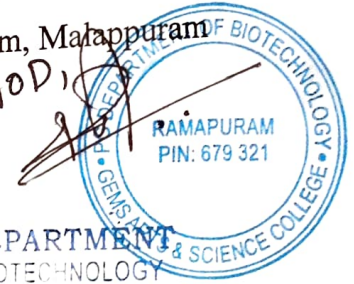
